

Episode 108: "Disguises" - Activity 8

Acquire a set of clean artificial, demonstration, or toy teeth. Allow your child to explore the set of teeth. Have your child examine his/her teeth using a child-safe mirror. Provide your child with clay. Encourage him/her to mold a set of teeth using the clay. If suitable volunteers are available, allow your child to examine other people's teeth and recreate them using clay. Create a display corner for the sets of clay teeth. Label the display corner " Los dientes." You may want to label the clay teeth models with the names of people they represent (e.g., los dientes de Joe or los dientes de papá). Extend the activity by learning the names of the different types of teeth and their purposes.
