

Episode 208: "Portrait of the Artist as a Young Pig" - Activity 38

Take advantage of opportunities to reinforce shapes (círculo, triángulo, and rectángulo) while you and your child engage in daily activities. Examples of such opportunities include:

- When setting a table for a meal, name the shapes found in the plates, napkins, etc.
- When playing with construction toys, name the shapes of the pieces and the shapes created by locking the pieces together.
- When riding in the car, find shapes inside the automobile and outside as you pass by.
- When reading a book with your child, name the shape of the book as well as shapes found in the illustrations.
- When working at the computer, name the shapes of the hardware.
- When riding in the car, find road signs in the shape of "triángulos, rectángulos, and círculos."
