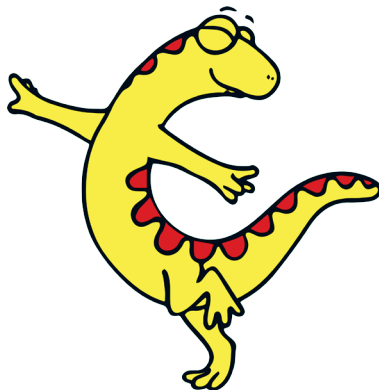

Episode 112: “The Wolf’s Share” - Activity 12

While visiting a fast food restaurant, sample the french fries (las papas fritas.) Ask your child to identify the food using the Spanish name. Smell the fries and ask your child to describe the aroma. Ask your child to tell words, phrases, or sentences that describe how the fries taste. Ask your child to tell how the fries look and feel to the touch. Write (you or your child) these ideas/observations on a sheet of paper. Upon returning home, make a chart like the one below. Record descriptive words, phrases, or sentences on the chart in the correct column. Discuss the differences between words, phrases, and sentences. Discuss the purposes of using descriptive language. Label the chart “Las papas fritas.” Encourage your child to illustrate the chart with examples of “las papas fritas.”



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
