

Episode 129: “The Red Shoes” - Activity 29

Organizing and keeping up with personal items like “zapatos “ (shoes) is often a problem for many children. Discuss the importance of being able to keep track of your personal things. Discuss the importance of being organized. Have your child find and count his/her pairs of “zapatos” (shoes) in Spanish. Ask your child if he/she can think of a way to organize his/her “zapatos” so they are always together and easily located. Discuss your child’s ideas. Implement a mutually agreeable system. After a few days, chat with your child about its success. Try another of your child’s ideas if the first one does not work out. Repeated activities of this nature and supportive discussions will enable your child to build responsibility, organizational skills, and self-worth.



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
