5.	 beryllium fluoride + magnesium yields magnesium fluoride + beryllium
6.	 aluminum sulfate + barium chloride yields aluminum chloride + barium sulfate
7.	 zinc metal + oxygen gas yields zinc oxide
8.	ethane + oxygen gas yields carbon dioxide and water
