## Nouns

**Adaptation:** a change in a plant or animal that makes it better able to live in a particular place or situation

**Artifact:** something that was made by people in the past

**Camouflage:** an animal's natural coloring or form that enables it to blend in with its surroundings

**Carnivore:** Something that eats meat

**Ecosystem:** everything that exists in a particular environment, including living and non-living things

**Exploration:** to look at something in a careful way to learn more about it

**Folklore:** ideas or stories that are not true but that many people have heard or read

**Habitat:** the place or type of place where a plant or animal lives or grows

**Migration:** when an organism moves from one location to another usually on a seasonal basis

**Okefenokee:** Native American word meaning "land of the trembling earth"

**Peat:** a dark material made of decaying plants

**Predator:** an animal that lives by killing and eating other animals

**Pioneer:** someone who is one of the first people to move to and live in a new area

**Prairie:** A large, mostly flat area of land in North America that has few trees and is covered in grasses

**Prey:** an animal hunted or taken for food, especially by a meat-eating animal

**Swamp:** land that is always wet and often partly covered with water

**Wetland:** an area of land that is covered with shallow water

## Adjectives

**Cold-blooded:** having a body temperature that is similar to the temperature of the environment

**Diverse:** different from each other

**Endangered:** a type of animal or plant that could die out completely because there are not many left

**Inaccessible:** difficult or impossible to reach

**Parasitic:** living in or on another animal or plant and getting food or protection from it

**Remote:** far away from other people, houses, cities, etc.

**Vast:** very great in size

**Warm-blooded:** having a body temperature that does not change when the temperature of the environment changes
