

Sonnet Facts!

- ❖ **Sonnetto: “little song”**
- ❖ **All sonnets are 14 lines**
- ❖ **Iambic pentameter: fixed 5 beats per line**
Ex: So far from home into my deeds to pry
– Sonnet LXI



Shakespearean (English) sonnet

- ❖ **3 Quatrains; 1 couplet:**
 - **ABAB**
 - **CDCD**
 - **EFEF**
 - **GG**
- ❖ **There may be a “turn” where the poet changes his thought or turns in another direction**
- ❖ **Most sonnets turn, or shift in tone or focus, after the 1st eight lines—a surprise may occur in the couplet**
- ❖ **1st eight lines=octave**
- ❖ **Last 6 lines=sestet**
