



One bright, sunny day...





Oakly watched the sky suddenly turn very dark. "I'm a tree. I need sunlight to make my own food," he thought.




Oakly looked up,

just like the sun."




Oakly knew Lunarous needed to be moved quickly because photosynthesis is necessary

space because in his mind, the moon was a sphere of cheese.




When those mice landed,





they discovered the moon was actually made of rocks.

out of the way."






So he huffed, and he puffed, but he couldn't blow Lunarous back into orbit. "Lunarous didn't move, my plan failed badly."

your own light,





so I could


How about that?"
